Diana: I'd like a glass of red wine.

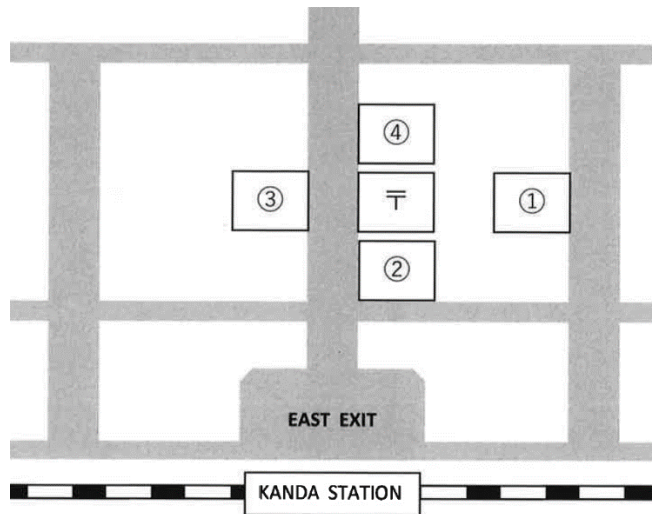
Hiroki: Just a glass of water, please.

In the village, he saw their famous dance called “Haka” by students of his sister school. He was very \*impressed because they looked strong, cool and their dance was very nice. After the welcome party finished, Satoshi moved to a hotel and stayed there that day. He felt happy to join the program and thought his trip would be wonderful.

The next day, Satoshi went to his sister school. In the morning, he had an English class with some Japanese students. It was not very difficult and Satoshi felt that the class in the afternoon was easy too. But it wasn't. After lunch, he had a history class with only students of New Zealand. He couldn't understand the class at all. He lost his \*confidence.

Satoshi wanted to go back to Japan. He didn't want to stay there anymore. But he remembered the words of his teacher, Mr. Nakao. Satoshi talked to him, “The class is too difficult for me. I can't understand it. I don't want to join the class.” Mr. Nakao said, “First, it is difficult for everyone to understand the class of the foreign school. You should ask the teacher some questions if you don't understand it. Then, he will answer your questions and you will be able to understand it. Let's try to ask questions in English!”

Satoshi still lost his confidence, but he thought Mr. Nakao's advice was good. Satoshi had the same history class. It was very difficult, too. But he walked to the teacher and asked some questions. The teacher answered his questions kindly and Satoshi understood the class better. \*Through the program, Satoshi learned that

he must not give up easily and how important it is to ask questions when he has problems.
